Medicaid (MoHealth Net) Quick Reference

You may be eligible if you are a:

- Senior (65 and older)
- Parent or caretaker with a child (under age 19)
- Child (birth -18)
- Woman (ages 18-55) with no health insurance
- Adult (ages 19-64) without disabilities
- Pregnant woman (including unborn child)
- Woman (under age 65) with breast or cervical cancer
- Person with disabilities
- Blind or visually impaired adult

Information needed to apply

- Social Security Numbers or document numbers for legal immigrants
- W-2 forms or wage and tax statements for everyone in your household
- Current health insurance policy numbers (if applicable)
- Employer health insurance policy numbers (if applicable)
